

A SCARF

Materials: 4 oz. of Jaeger "Super-Spun" ("J.S." Quality) Fingering, 4 -ply, (9d. per oz.), and 1 pair of No. 7 Jaeger knitting needles.

Measurements: Length, 50 inches; width, 9.5 inches.

Tension: 6 stitches to 1 inch in width, and 15 rows to 2 inches in depth.

Abbreviations: K. = knit;

p. = purl; sts. = stitches; rep. = repeat.

Casting-on: If you cast on with two needles work into the back of all cast on sts. to produce firm edges, but if you use the thumb method this is not necessary.

Begin at the lower edge. Cast on 58 sts. using No. 7 needles and work in pattern as follows: **1st row** - * K.4, p.4. Rep. from * finishing k.2. This row forms the pattern. Continue in pattern until the work measures 50 inches from the beginning. Cast off. Press the work on the wrong side with a warm iron and damp cloth.
