



A Baroque Hat

The spirit of the Baroque combines Ornament, Extravagance and Theatricality and can be seen through the Art and Design of the early 18th century.

This hat reflects all the exuberance of this grand style.

You will need

Thin white card, glue, scissors, pencil, ruler, gold ribbon and gold paper or coloured pencils for decoration.

Instructions

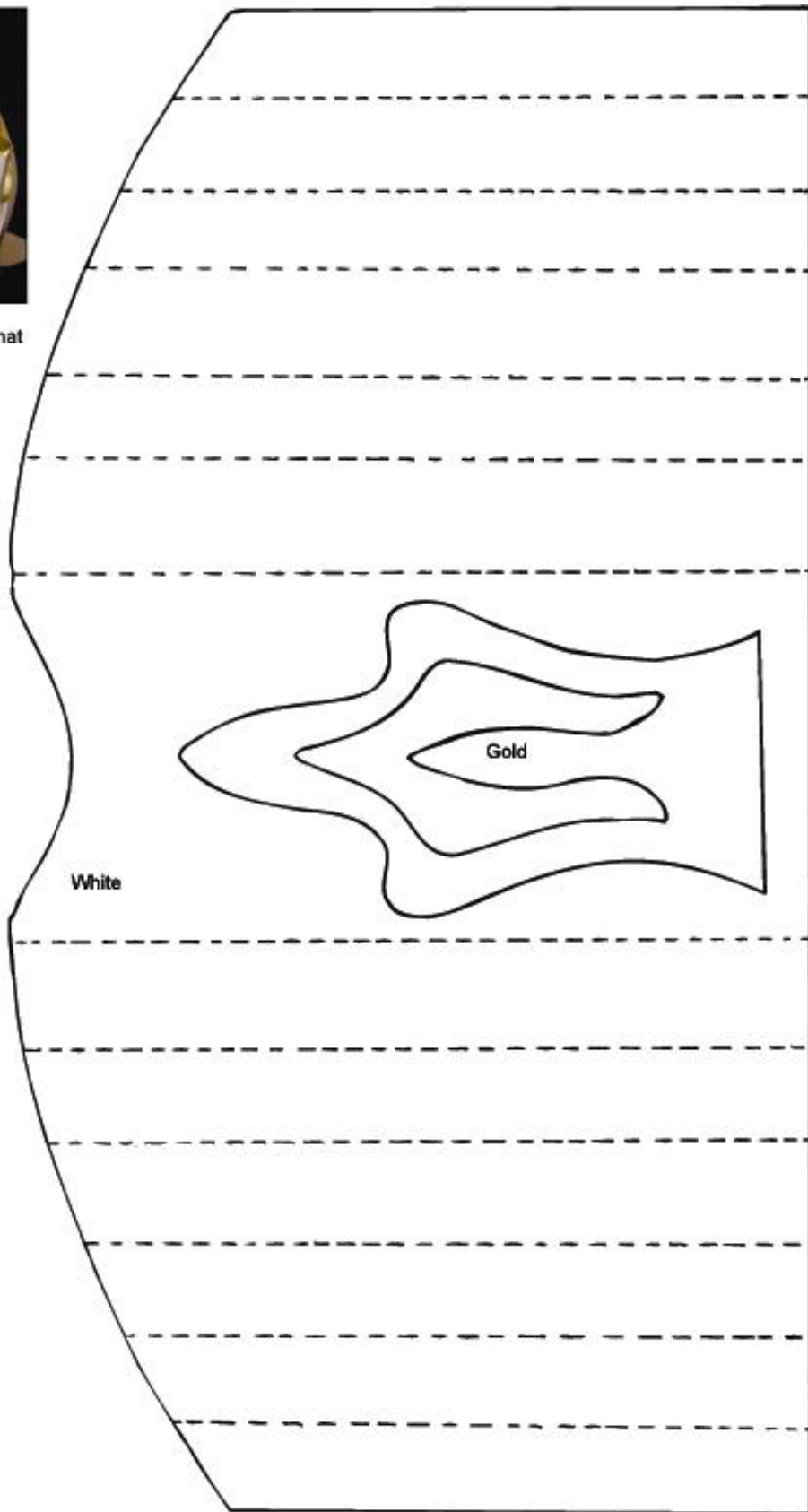
- i. Cut a strip of white card, 2cm wide to fit the circumference of your head. Glue ends together to make a band.
- ii. Cut out templates and transfer to thin card. Draw out the required number and cut out.
- iii. Decorate each piece with gold paper or coloured pencils.
- iv. Pleat in the front panel, glue pleated ends together and glue to front of the head band.
- v. Glue leaves onto head band starting from the centre back.
- vi. Add side scrolls by gluing to the side of the band and the first fold of the front panel. Attach sun disc to the top of the pleated panel.
- vii. To complete the hat you can add a gold ribbon at the back.

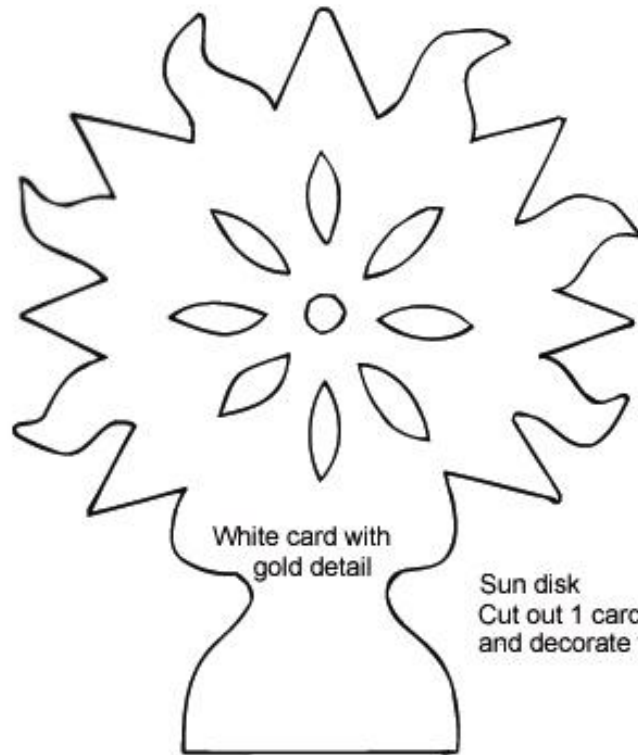


Front view of finished hat

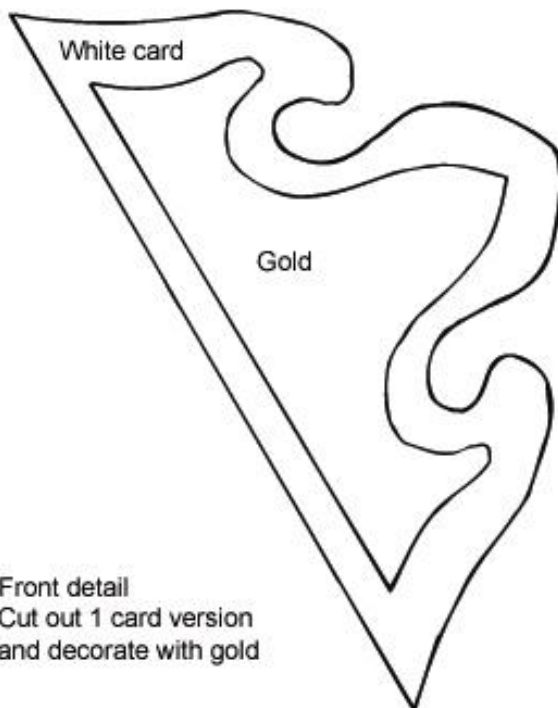




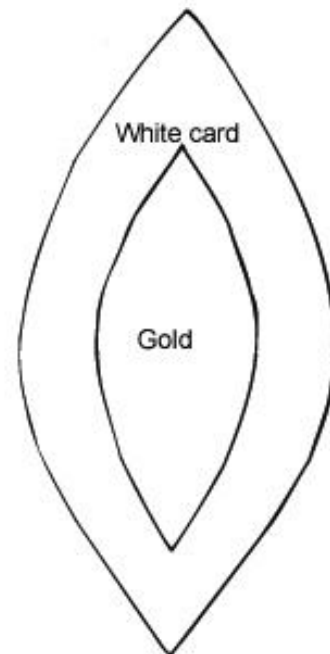
Back view of finished hat

and decorate with gold



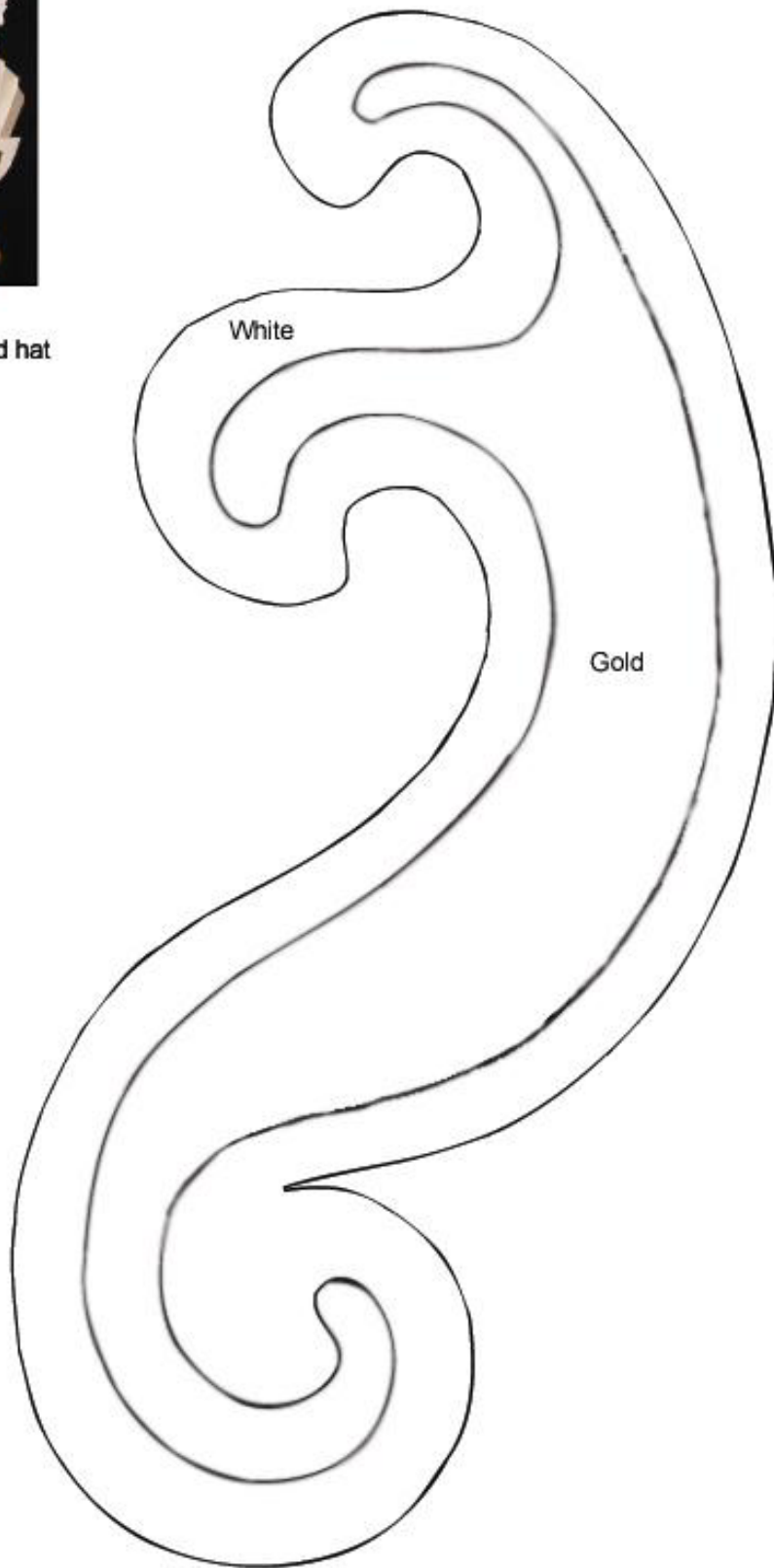
Front detail
